Council held a regular meeting March 13, 2018.

- Town Council had no objections to the proposed creation of Parcel A in the SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 13-34-9-W3M located in the R.M. of Vanscoy.
- The membership with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities was renewed.
- The bid of \$573,850.00 plus taxes submitted by Suer & Pollon Mechanical for the Contract 2 Tender for Well and Water Treatment Plant upgrades was accepted. An additional \$8,000 was added to this contract for the installation of epoxy flooring in the water treatment plant.
- The administrator was authorized to initiate Tax Enforcement proceedings against five properties.
