He's the first Canadian Miniature Schnauzer to have ever achieved this ranking. AmGCh.CanGCh. Minuteman Justified or "Raylan" was exhibited at shows across America from Oregon to Texas to Florida and many points in between. He was judged Best Miniature Schnauzer at 52 events, including the American National Specialty in Los Angeles. "Raylan" was handled throughout his career by his breeder-owner, Catherine (Kate) McMillan of Delisle. Town residents may have spotted the small grey dog being "road worked" alongside her bicycle on occasion and we just thought we should share his achievements!
