Due to changes in world markets, Loraas Disposal has announced that plastic bags are no longer considered recyclable. **DO NOT** place plastic bags or film in your blue recycle bins. Instead, it is now considered waste and should be placed in your garbage bin.

**COMPOST** will be picked up on October 9<sup>th</sup> & October 23<sup>th</sup> (**WEATHER PERMITTING**). Compost will be picked up in the back alley and should be in a 17 gallon capacity plastic or metal can. **OCTOBER 9<sup>th</sup> & OCTOBER 23<sup>rd</sup>** will have garden waste collected during compost pickup without any need to package the garden waste. The town will collect garden waste provided it is in a convenient area in the back alley.
