ANNUAL WATERWORKS REPORT

The following is information on the Town of Delisle's waterworks, as required under *The Municipalities Regulations*:

2016 Waterworks Financial Overview

Total water & sewer revenue - \$267,388

Total water & sewer expenses - \$344,362

Total debt payments - NIL

Comparison of revenues to expenses plus debt

payments expressed as a ratio –

$\$267,388 / \$344,362 + \text{NIL} = .78$

For 2016, water & sewer revenues covered 78% of water & sewer expenditures. This is an improvement of 5% from last year.

COMPOST PICK-UP

Compost will be picked up on Tues., September 12th & 26th. Compost will be picked up in the back alley and should be in a 17 gallon capacity plastic or metal can. **On Sept. 26th**, garden waste will be collected during compost pickup without any need to package the garden waste. The town will collect garden waste provided it is in a convenient area in the back alley. This service is only for garden waste and only available on Sept. 26th. Grass clippings must still be in an open container or bin that can be easily dumped.
