- Council held a regular meeting Dec. 13th/16.

- A new fire and protective services agreement with the City of Saskatoon was approved. The City of Saskatoon will provide services if our local fire department requires assistance.
- A bylaw outlining a code of ethics for members of council was passed.

From the desk of Ron J. Klassen - Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Bylaw No. 2-2009 Sec. 4 (L) Parking (6) States that “no person shall park a vehicle on any street or highway at one place for any period of time exceeding 48 (forty eight) consecutive hours”.
